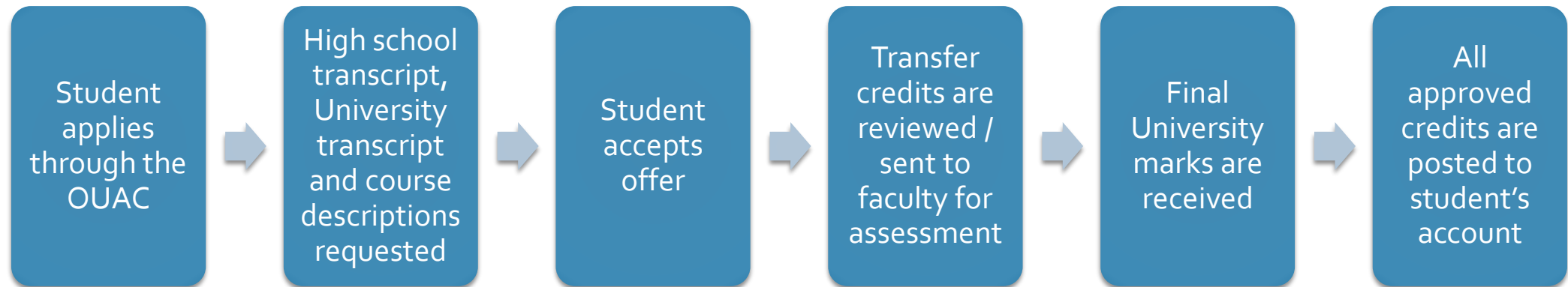

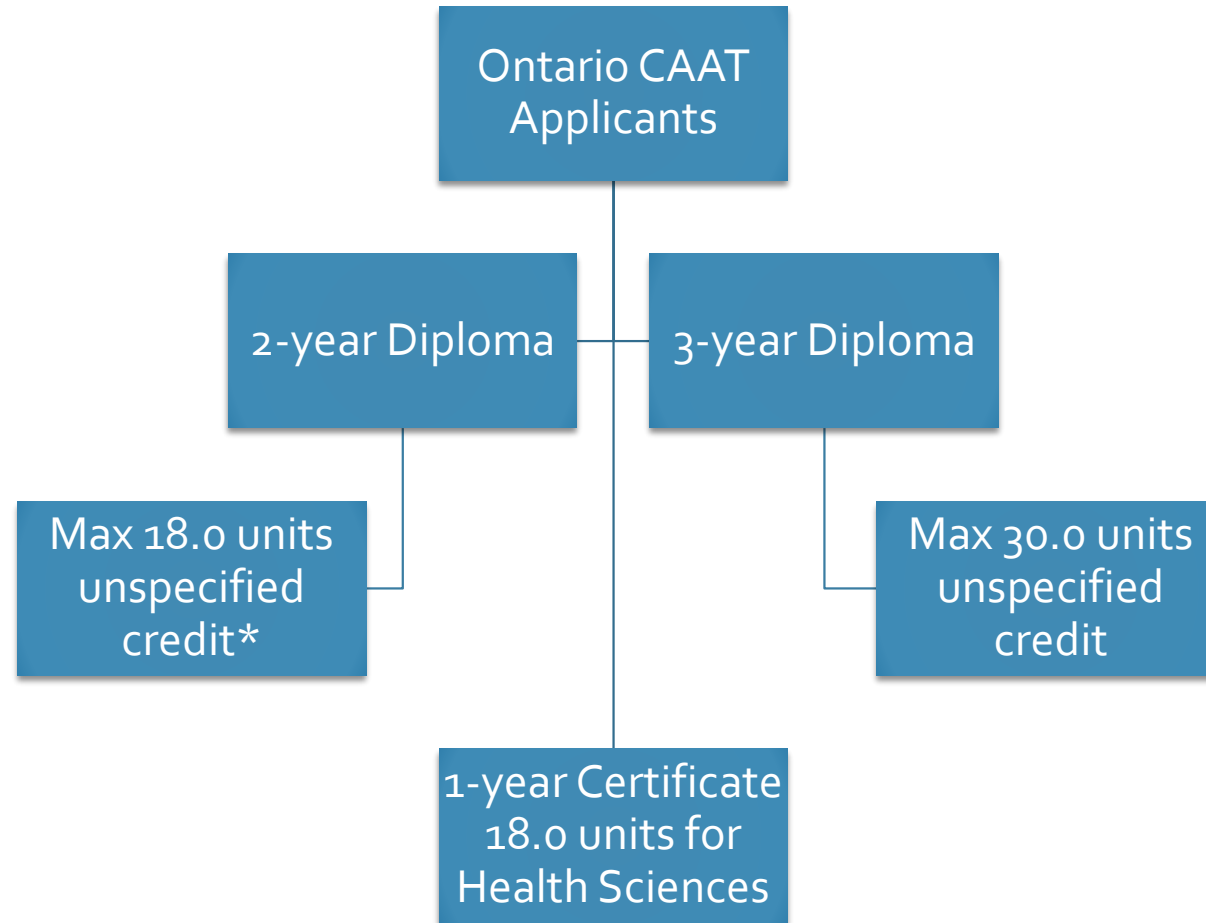
Transferring to Queen's

- Transfer applications accepted for Arts, Science, Computing Commerce, Engineering and Nursing
- Second Degree applications also accepted for Arts, Science and Computing
- Over 1,100 Upper-year applications received in 2017
- Over 3,600 units of transfer credit granted in 2017

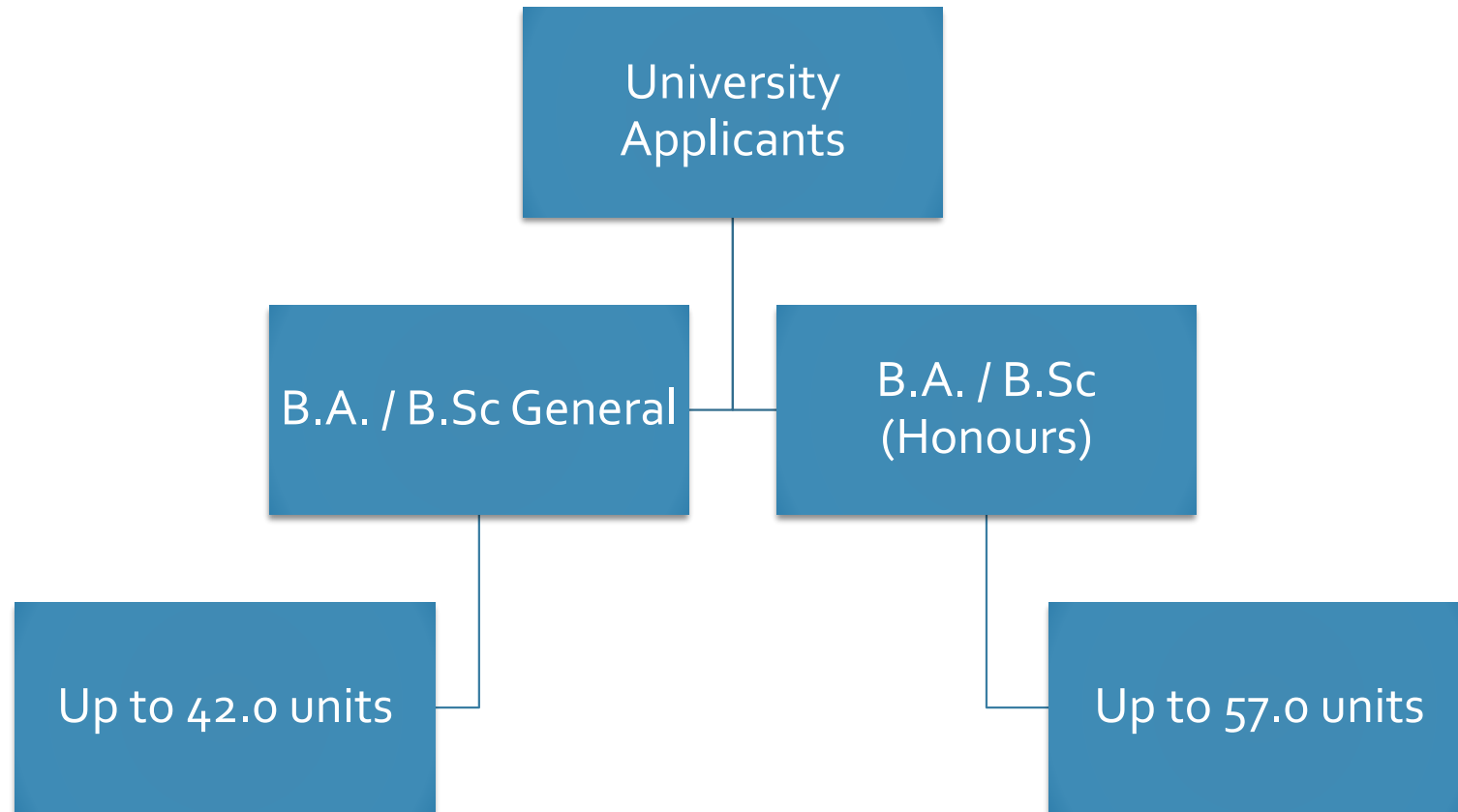
The Transfer Credit Process

Queen's Transfer Credit History

- As early back as 2014 most information was shared with departments by photocopying and sending via internal mail. This included course descriptions, departmental requests and statement of transfer credit
- Long delays in departments receiving the information was common and the same was true for sending the information back to the Admissions office
- Course assessments were tracked manually. Once returned, credits would be added manually to PeopleSoft
- Wait time varied drastically and there was no capacity for pre-assessments before a student has been admitted

Advancements to Evaluation Process

A number of changes have been made recently to the transfer credit evaluation process at Queen's to help improve efficiency:

- Electronic course description submission form
- Emailed assessment requests to faculties
- ONTransfer.ca database / Queen's Database integration
- PeopleSoft advancements for automation (in testing)

Processing Timelines

- The transfer credit assessment process starts as soon as a student has accepted their offer and submitted the required documents
- Assessment requests are emailed out to each department as needed
- Assessments are tracked after the initial email has been sent to the department requesting evaluation. Reminder emails sent as required
- Service standard for return of assessments is ideally less than 2 weeks time

Transfer Credits – By the Numbers

- In 2017 Queen's faculty evaluated over 1,175 new courses for incoming students
- The Undergraduate Admission transfer credit database at Queen's currently holds over 4,600 individual credit equivalencies

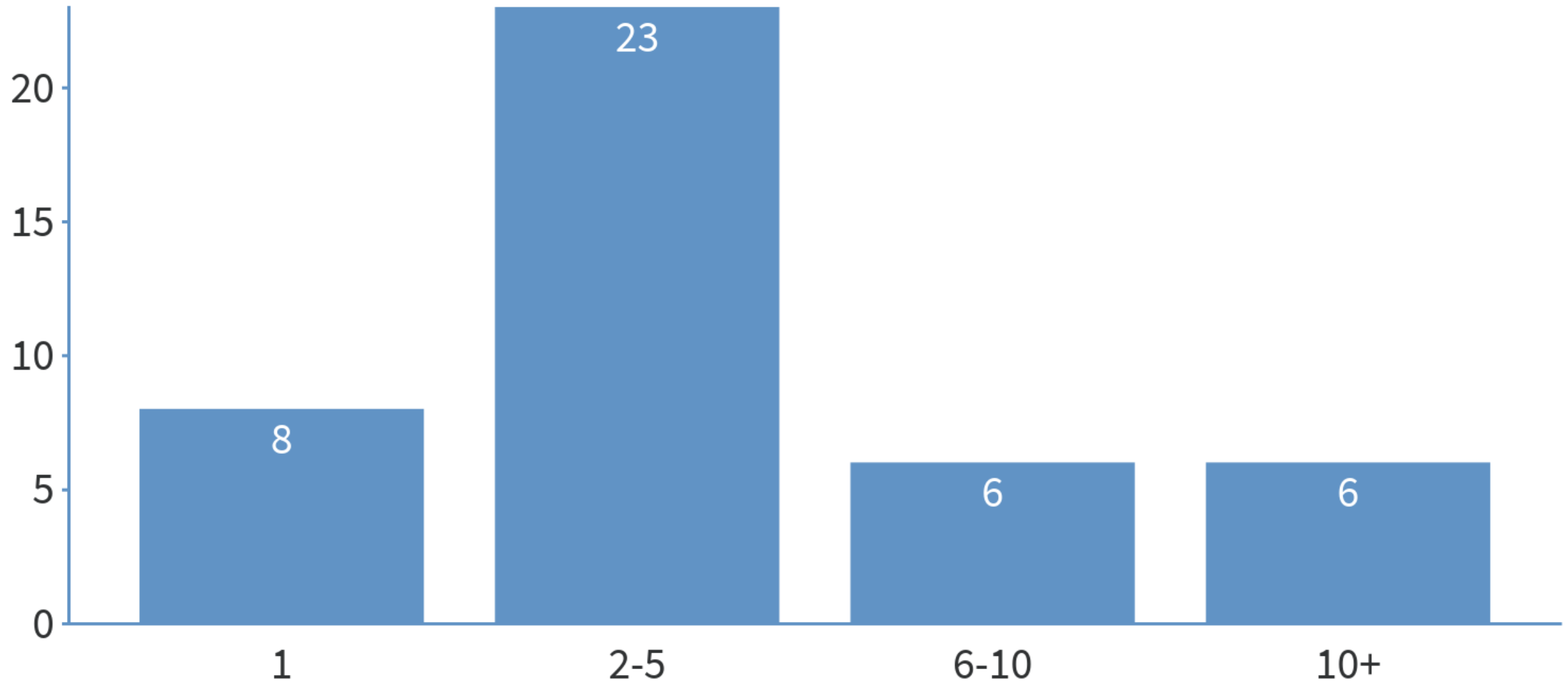
Which institution are you joining us from today?



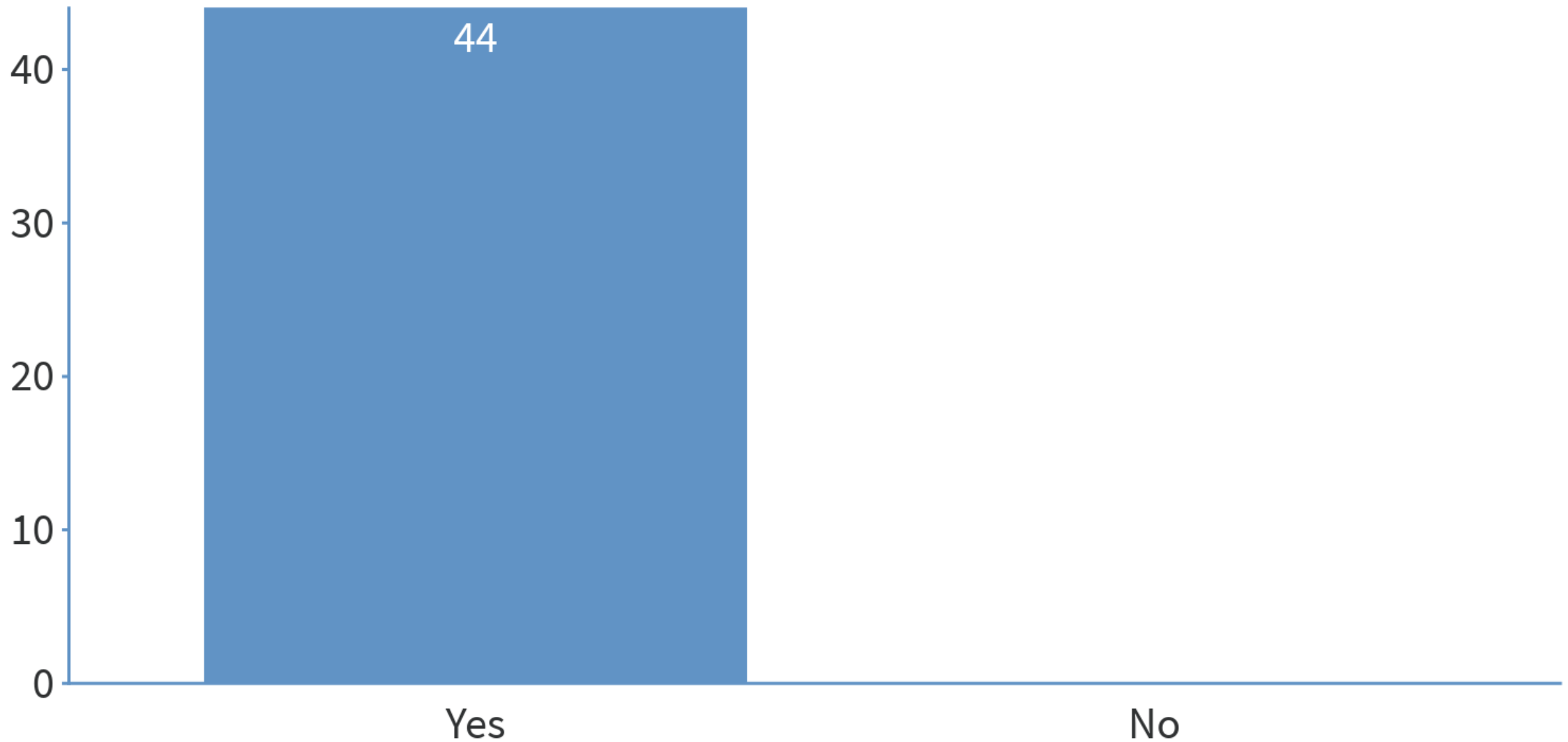

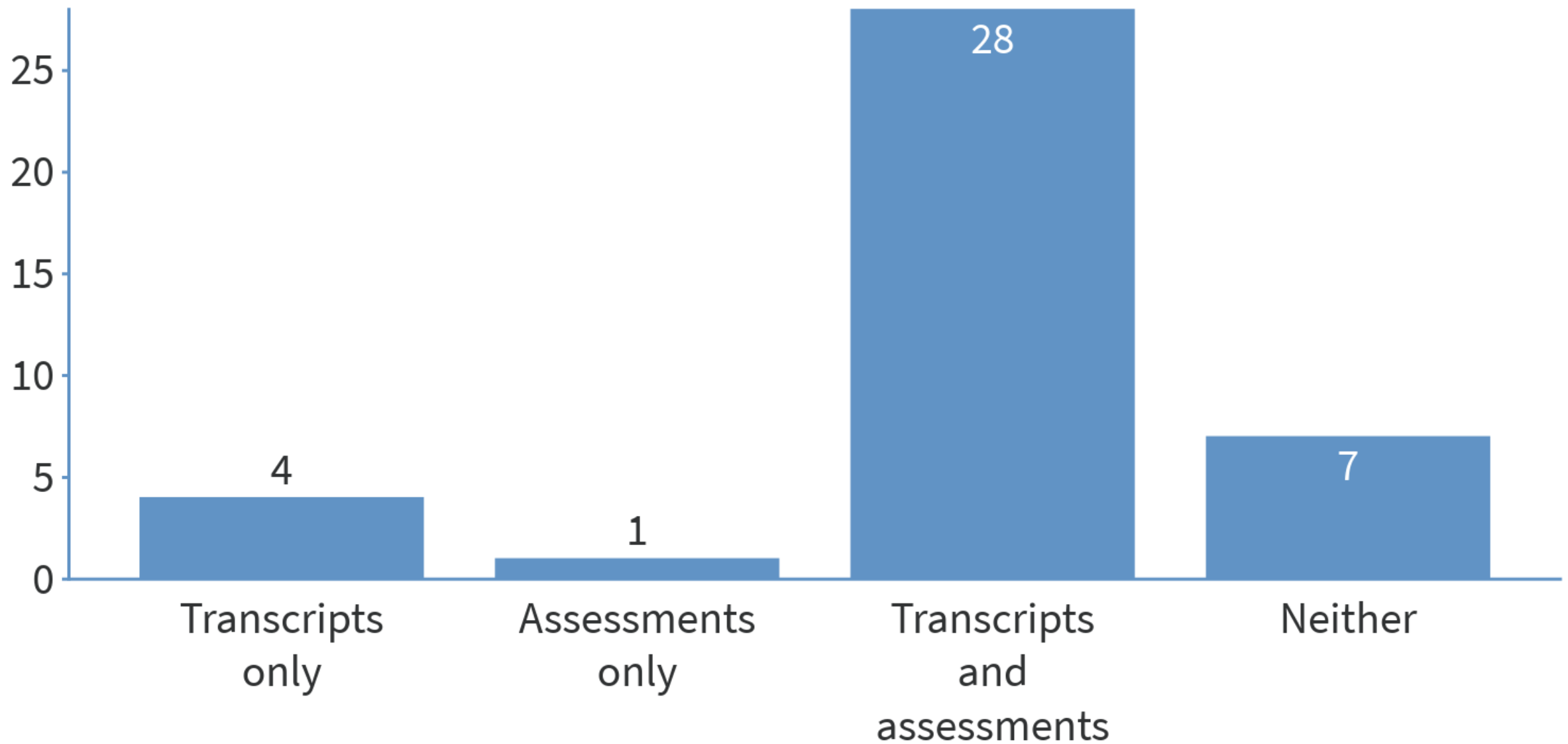
How many employees in your institution are dedicated to working with transfer students / credits?



Does your institution have its own equivalency database, separate from ONTransfer?



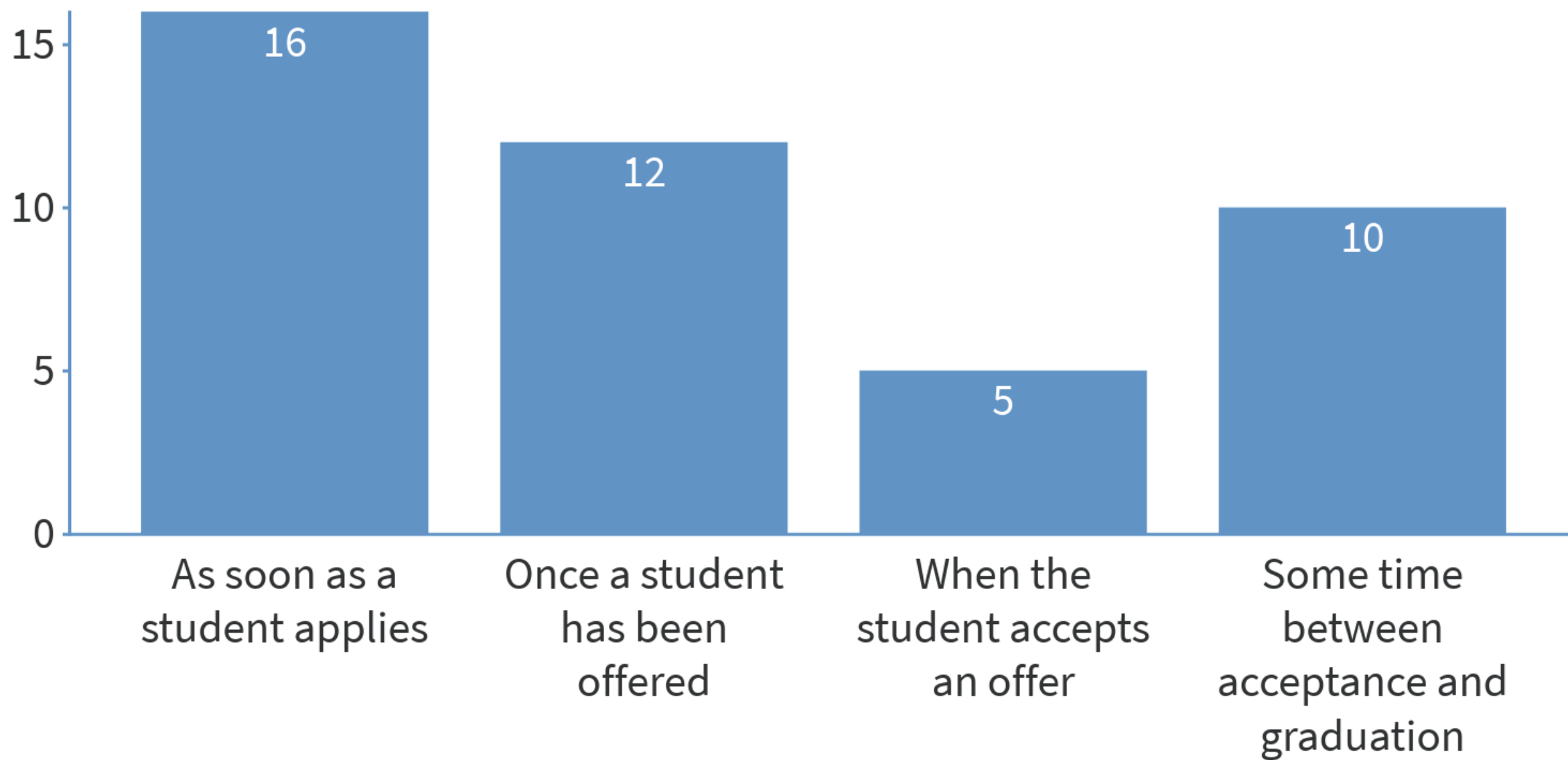
Do you accept WES assessments and/or transcripts?



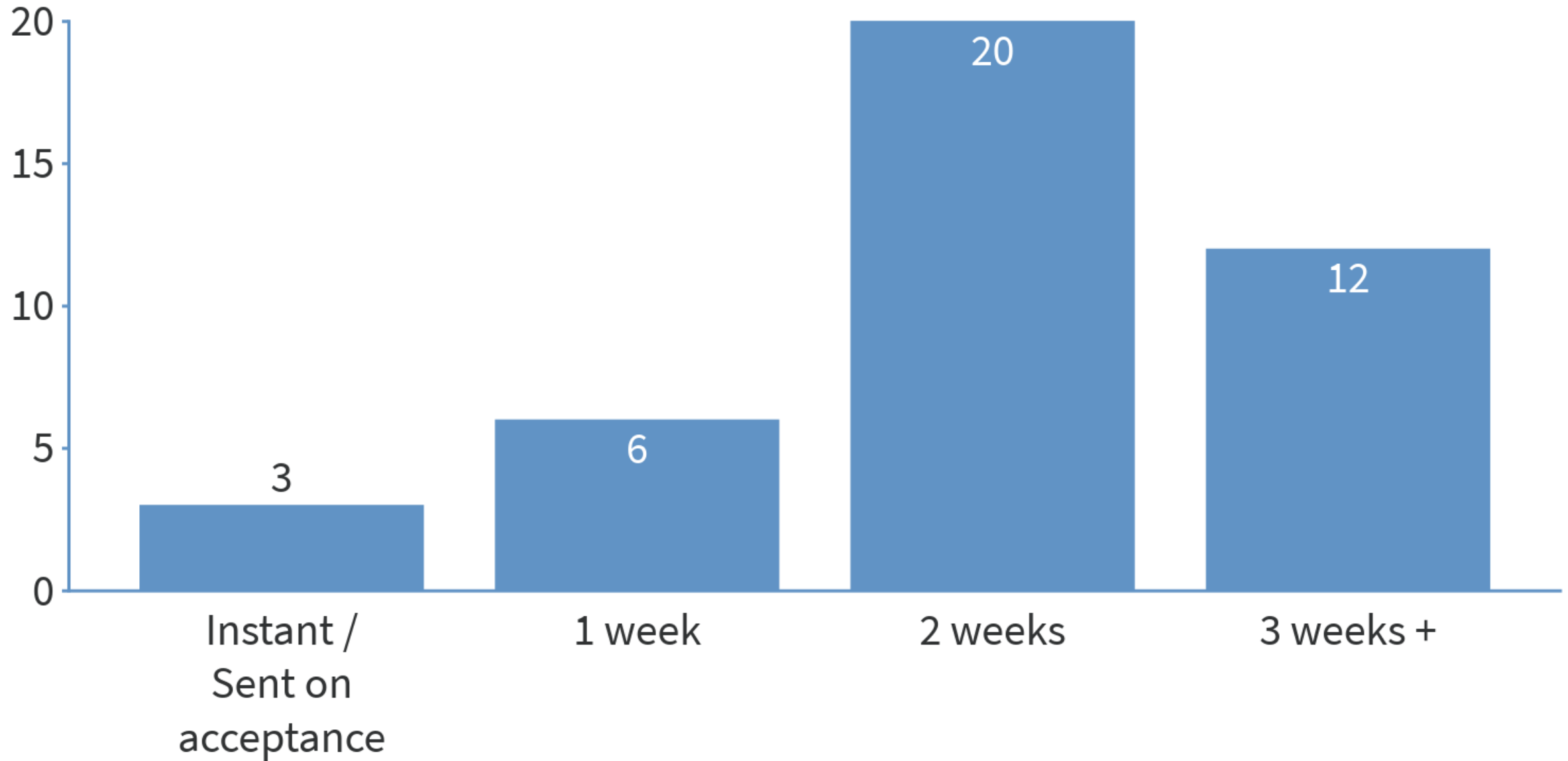
How many years is a course evaluation valid for at your institution?

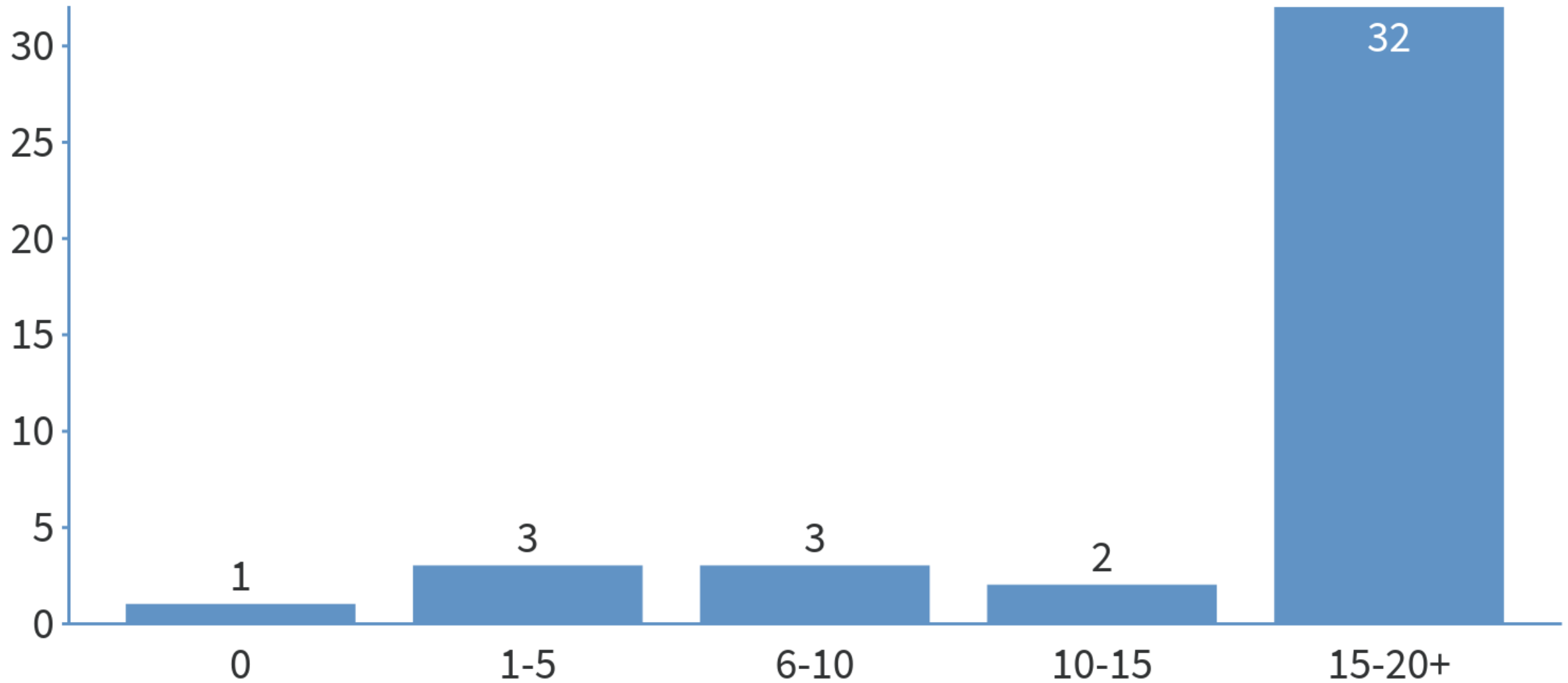
What is your turnaround time to complete a transfer credit assessment?



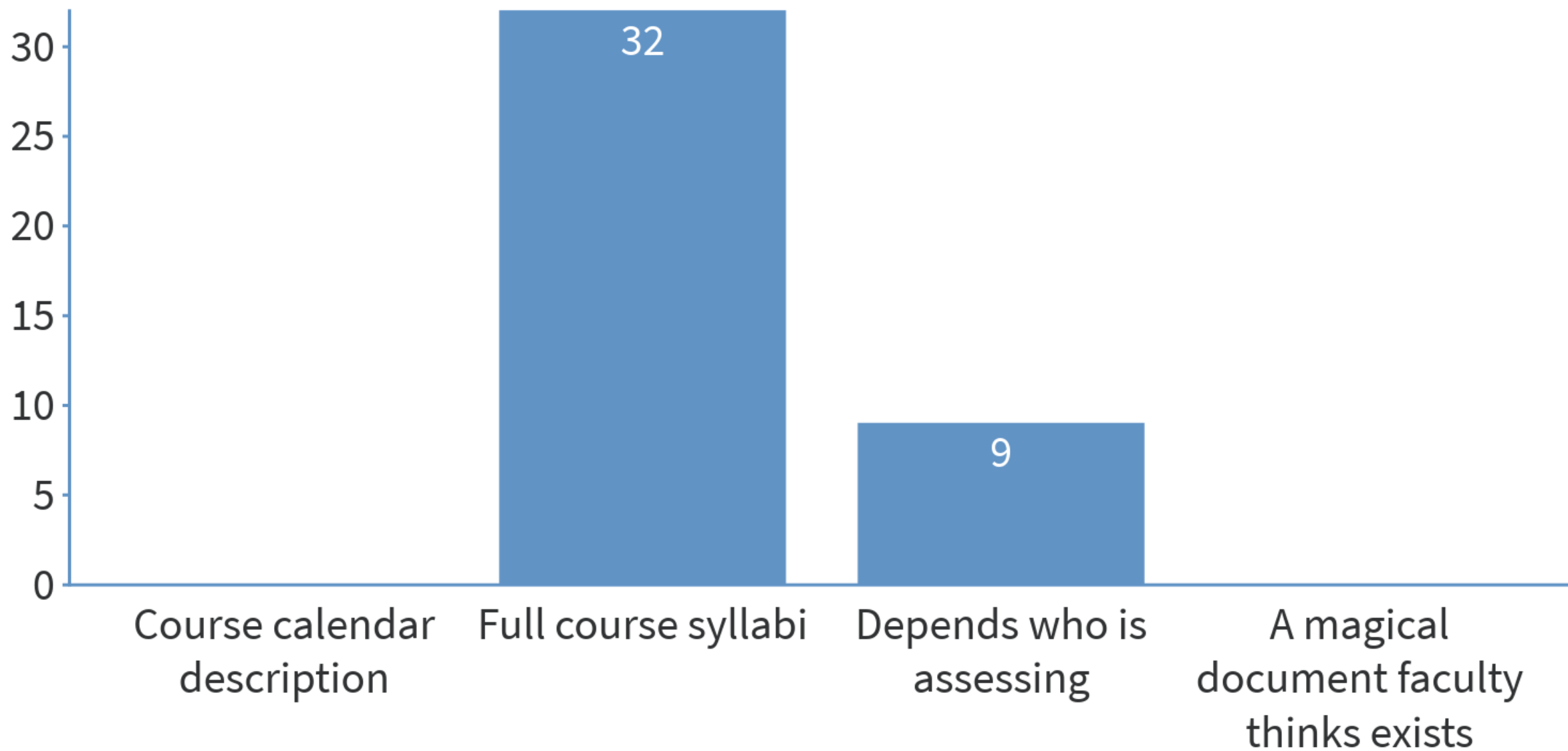
What is your institution's time frame for accepting previous courses?



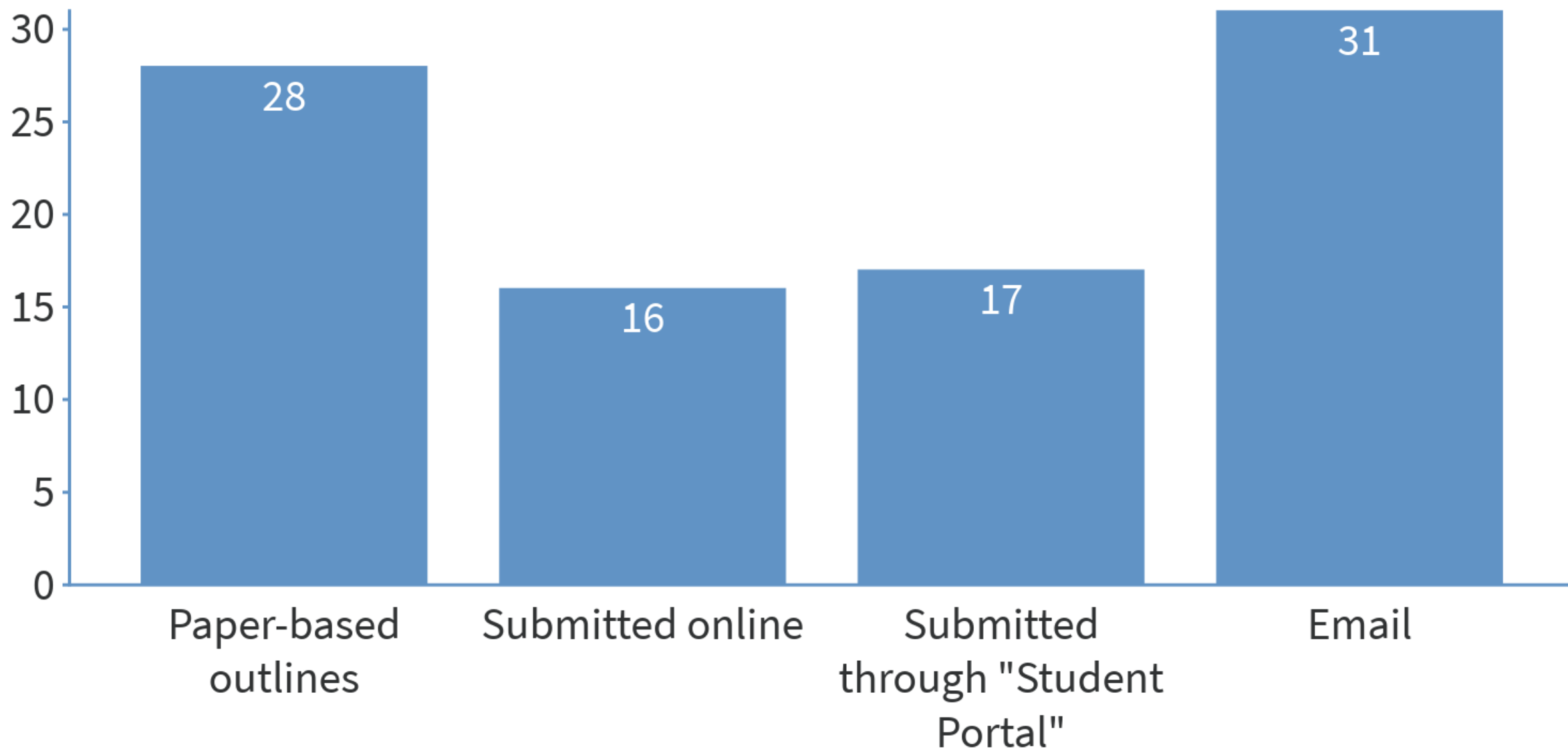
How many pathways or agreements does your institution have with other institutions?



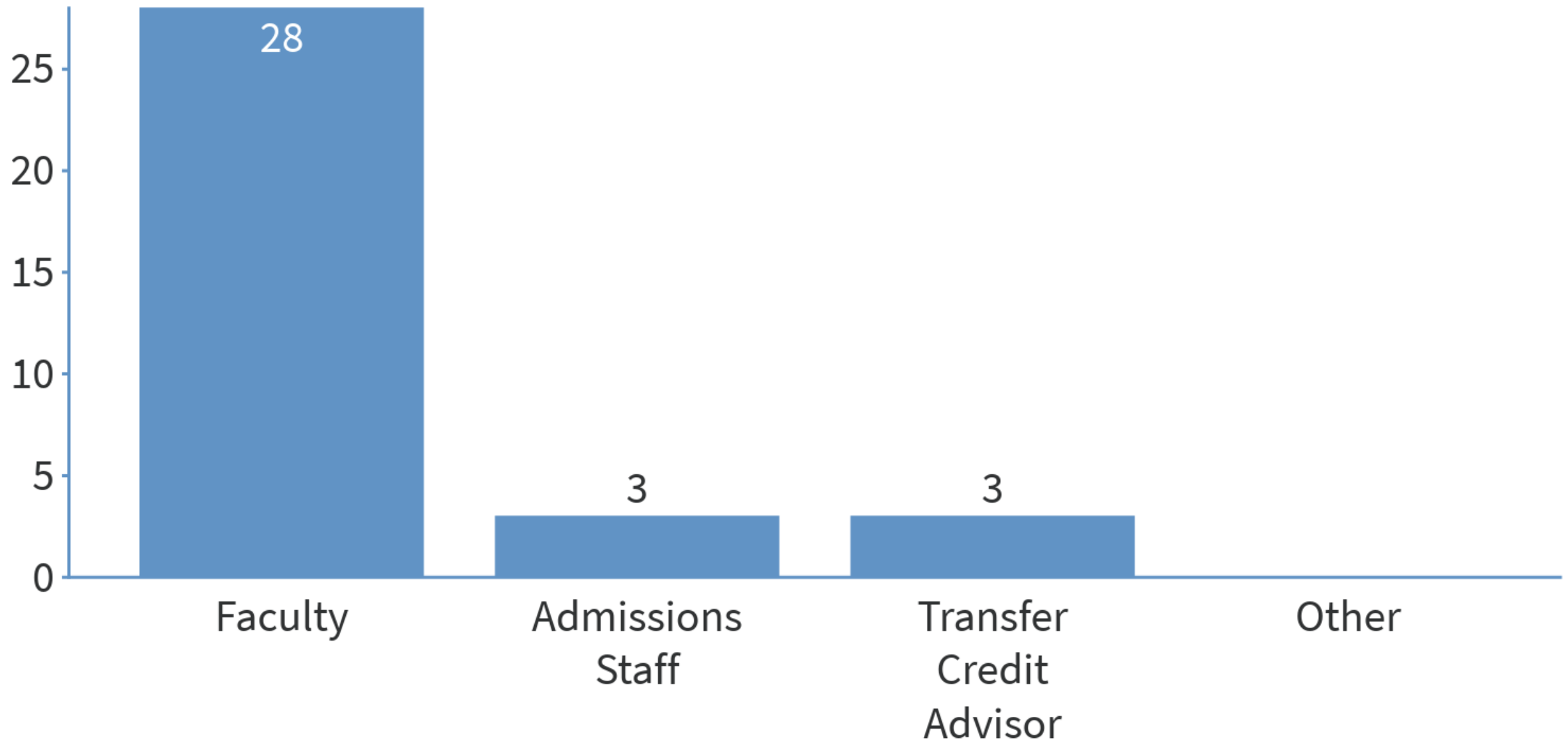
What type of information is required to complete an assessment?



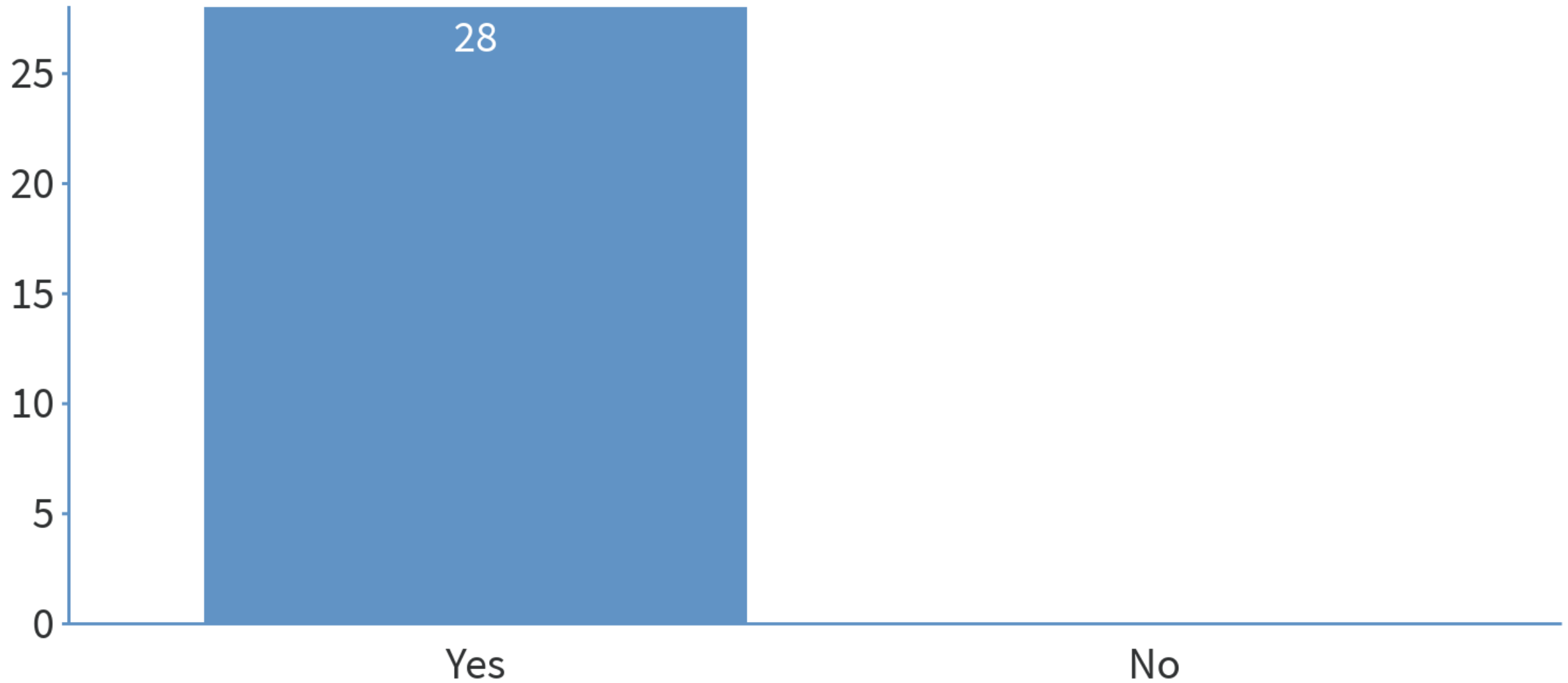
By which method(s) do you accept course information for assessment?



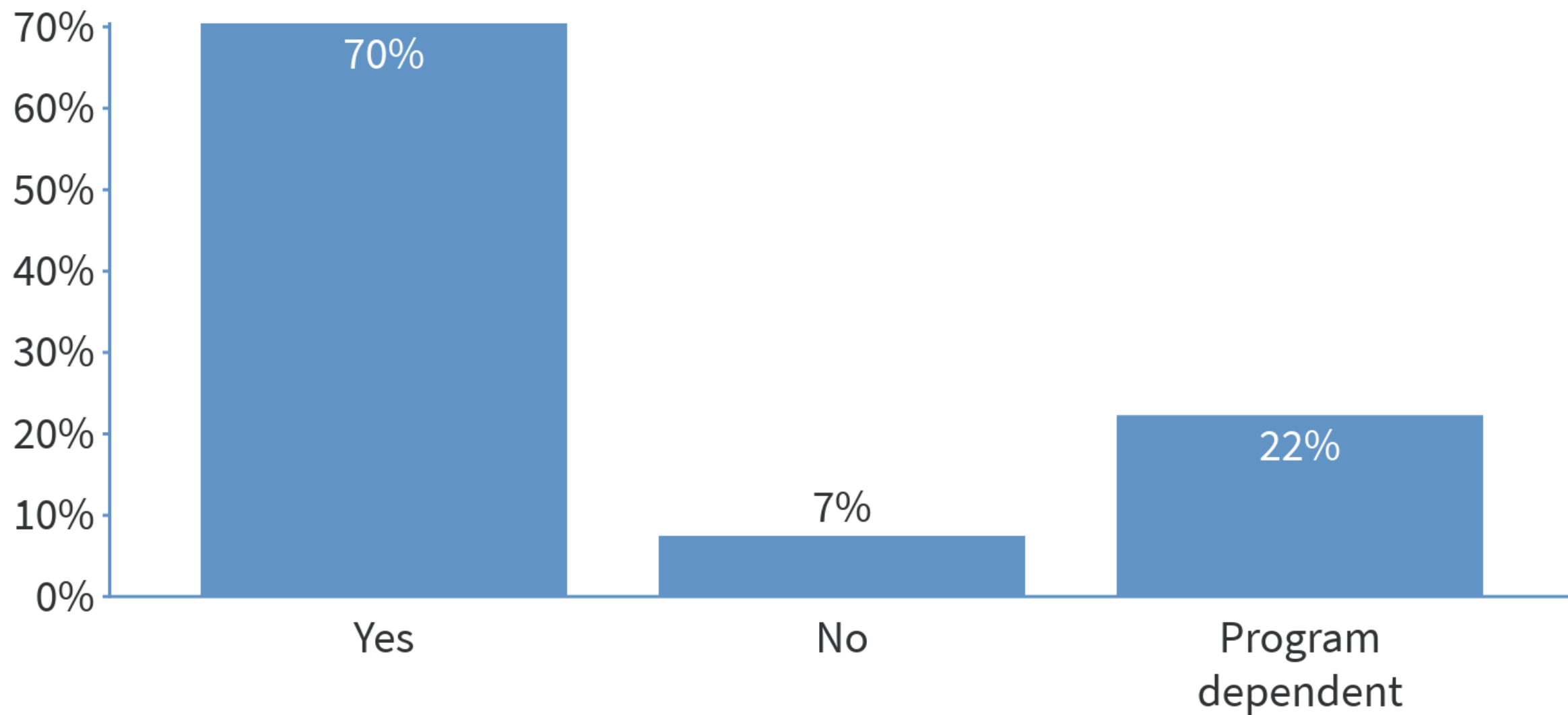
Who completes transfer credit evaluations at your institution?



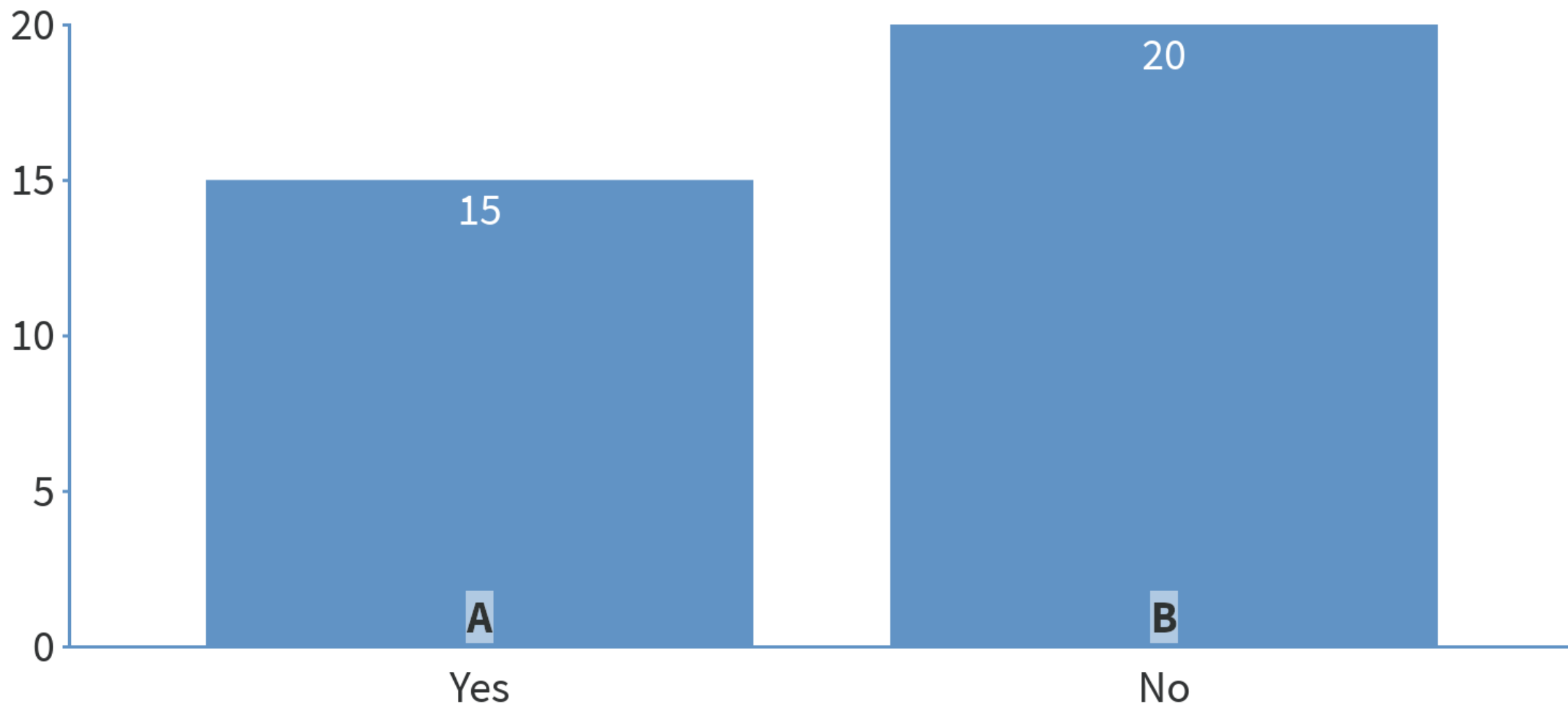
Do your programs accept transfer credits toward prerequisite courses? (Universities only)



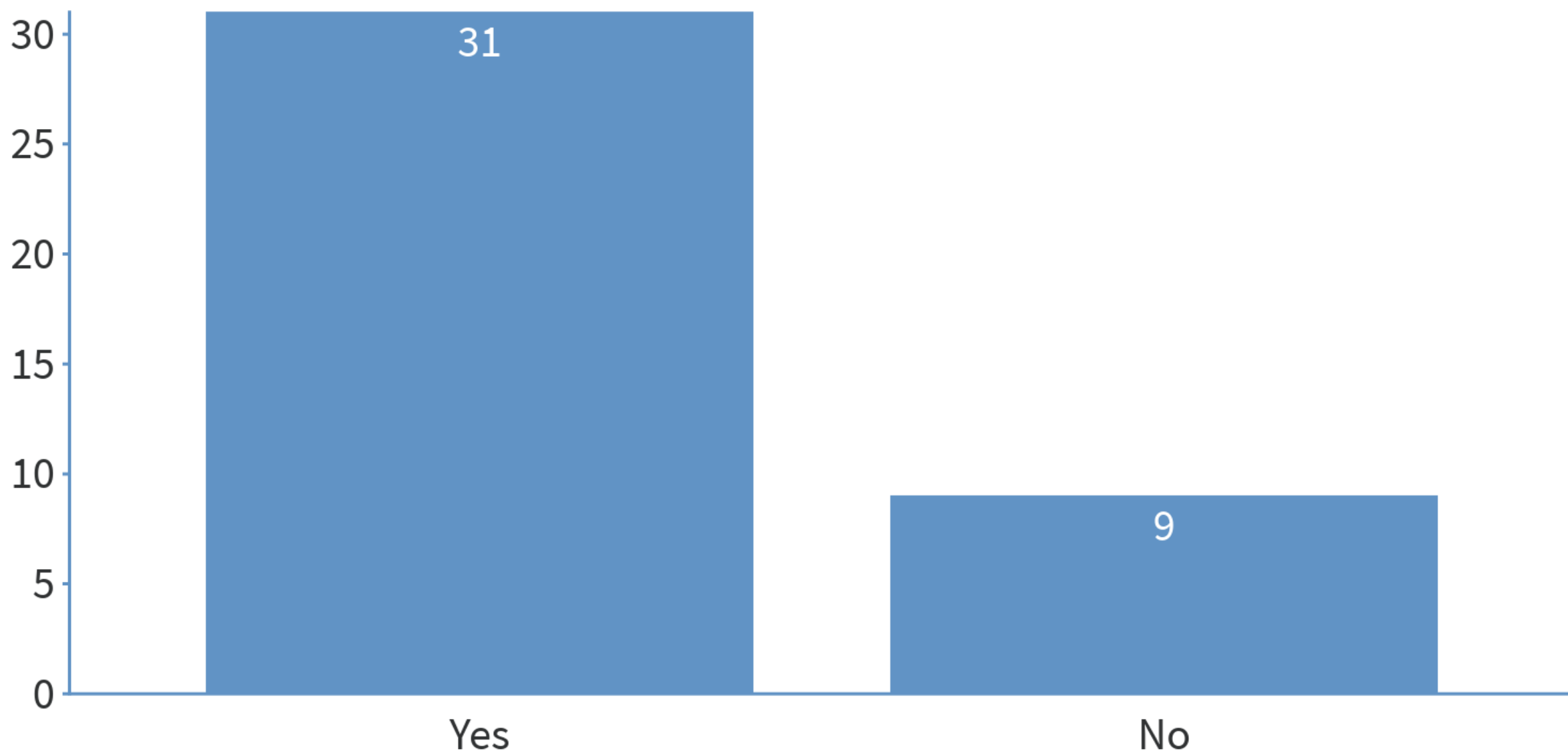
Does your institution accept Ontario College courses in place of high school prerequisites?
